- Maintain a high-quality standard of hygiene and housekeeping in the welfare facilities.
- Carry out Safety, Defect Checks prior to the use of any Machinery, Equipment and Mobile Plant including attachments.
- Unloading and loading of vehicles that require the use of Mobile Plant/FLT
- Carry out activities around the site that require the use of Mobile Plant/FLT
- Supporting the Team with the segregation and sorting of materials to maximise the recovery value for the Business
- Identify any non-conforming material that is being tipped on site as part of a load and report it immediately to the Shift Supervisor
